

## How to Download and Use the Audio Files for *What's Next?*

1. **Find the right audio file:** *What's Next?* Books 1 – 4 are now in Second Edition. Instructors still using First Edition books should be sure to download and use the First Edition audio files.  
  
Note: Introductory and Low Beginning Files are saved together for instructors using both level books together in the same class.
2. **Click to download:** Click on the audio file, which is a zip file that contains all the audio files for the book.
3. **Save the file** to your downloads folder or a new folder. The zip file downloads quickly and is about 120 MB.
4. **Extract the files:** Click on the zip file. A window will pop up. Click the "Extract" button. This will create a new folder with all the audio files inside.
5. **Organize the files:** If the files do not appear in order by lesson number (when downloading to a phone, sometimes they appear out of order), click on the three dots in the top right corner and select "Sort by" Name a – z.
6. **Play the audio files:** Double-click on the file you want to listen to.
  - ➔ If you have an iPhone or are on a computer: the file will open and begin playing.
  - ➔ If you have an Android phone: Your phone may prompt you to select an audio player. After you select your preferred audio player, the file will open and begin playing. Note: With some apps, such as SoundCloud, after opening the audio player, you will need to go back to your Downloads folder and open the file.

### File Names

- Stories are recorded at two speeds: Introductory (Intro) and Low Beginning (LB).
- Files named with "LB" are for activities in the Low Beginning books.
- Files named with "TG" are for activities in the Teacher's Guide.
- Listening Quizzes (files named Q1 – Q5) are for both the Beginning and Low Intermediate levels.
