ACTIVATE YOUR ACCOUNT

Option 1

- Watch the [Getting Started as a Student](#) video for a first look at the program you are about to begin.
- Find your activation email and click the blue “Complete Registration” link.
If you don't see the email, check your spam or junk folders.
- Log in and choose your password.
 - Bookmark this login page for future use.

Option 2

- Go to New Readers Press Online Learning at: <https://onlinelearning.newreaderspress.com/>
 - Bookmark this login page for future use.
- Log in with your email and the first-time temporary password provided by your organization.
- Change your password:
 - Click on the user icon in the upper-right corner.
 - Click on “My Learning Hub.”
 - Click “Account” and then click “My Account.”
 - Scroll down and change your preferred password.
 - Click “Save” at the bottom of the page to save your changes.



GET STARTED ON THE PLATFORM

- Click on “My Learning” at the top of the page. Click on “Not yet started” to find your courses. Click on “Study.”
 - After you have started a course, it will appear under “In progress.”
- If you would like to switch to a different course, use the drop-down to choose the subject you would like to study.
- Choose a target date for course completion.
 - This completion date helps the program determine how much you should study each day to finish the course by that date.
